

# **Application form**What is the CCRC?

The CCRC looks into cases where someone thinks they were wrongly convicted or their sentence was wrong.

If we think there is something wrong with a conviction or a sentence we can send the case back to the appeal court where it will be heard as an appeal.



You need to have appealed before applying to the CCRC.



There must be something NEW AND IMPORTANT in your case for the CCRC to be able to help.



The CCRC's job is to look at your case independently. This means we do NOT act as your lawyer. It also means we are independent of the police, the prosecution and the courts.

Fill out this form so we can look at your case if you think there is something wrong with your conviction or sentence but only if you have lost an appeal.

If you have not appealed there are different forms you need to fill in to start a first appeal direct to the courts.
